

CHOLAT AHAVA (Lovesick)

Israel

RECORDING: Cholat Ahava (Lovesick) *Shirley Tzafri*. Version for dancing.

FORMATIONS: Couples in Varsouvienne hold facing LOD (CCW around room). Follower's part could be danced solo. Also could be done as a mixer (see Fig E., meas 1).

CHOREOGRAPHER: Avi Levy, 2003.

METER: 4/4

INTRODUCTION: Instrumental, begin dance with singing.

Measure FIG. A: *Promenade*. Both start on the R foot.

- 1 Swivel to R as step R (ct 1), touch L tog (ct 2). Swivel to L as step L, touch R tog (cts 3-4).
- 2 M drops R arm, lifts L arm, and walks fwd R, L (cts 1-2) as W turns CW in 2 steps R, L. Both cha-cha (quick-quick-slow) R, L, R (ct 3&4) as re-turn to Varsouvienne hold.
- 3-4 Repeat meas 1-2, with opp ftwk: L, touch, R, touch, turn CCW under R arm, and cha-cha L,R,L. Rhythm during Fig A is SS,SS,SS,QQS (slowest part).

FIG. B: *Sway and Loop Left*.

- 1 Both step/sway R (ct 1), step/sway L (ct 2). M lifts both arms (don't let go!) and steps R, L turning in place $\frac{1}{4}$ CCW to face center (ct 3-4) while W turns $\frac{3}{4}$ CCW crossing in front of M in 2 steps R, L. End facing ptr with crossed-arm hold.
- 2 Both: Right back yemenite (quick-quick-slow): step back R, back L tog, fwd R (ct 1&2). Big step/sway L in front of ptr (ct 3). Drop R hds retaining L hds low as loop left: step R (ct 4).
- 3 Continue circling: walk L (ct 1), walk R (ct 2), cha-cha L, R, L (ct 3&4).
- 4 Both step/sway R sweeping R arm out (ct 1). Both step L, R, L turning CCW: M raising L arm as W spin/tucks into Varsouvienne hold (ct 2-4), end facing LOD the first time only, thereafter, turn $\frac{1}{4}$ more to face center.

Rhythm during Fig B is SS,SS,QQS (not as slow).

First time only: repeat Figs. A&B, then, facing center, go on to Fig. C.

FIG. C: Jump, Triangles and Twist. (C for Climax: busiest part of the dance, but most fun!)

- 1 Both jump wide-stance (ct 1), 2 hops on R as L swings behind (ct 2&), step L behind (ct 3), step R to R (ct &), cross L in front (ct 4) to complete first triangle, hold L as start to swing R around to front. Rhythm is SQQ, QQS.
- 2 2nd triangle: step R in front (ct 1) step back L (ct &), step R to R (ct 2), fwd L (ct &). Close R (ct 3), twist heels quickly R&L (ct &4), as if celebrating! Rhythm is QQ,QQ,QQS.

FIG. D: Rock and Separate. (Short “bridge between two seas”, Fig Cs that is.)

- 1 Step R to R (ct 1), cross L behind (ct 2), step R in place (ct &), same to left: step L to L (ct 3), cross R behind (ct 4), step L in place (ct &). Rhythm is SQQ,SQQ.
- 2 M lifts both arms (don't let go!) and steps R, L turning in place $\frac{1}{4}$ CW to face LOD (ct 1-2) while W turns $\frac{3}{4}$ CW in 2 steps R, L. End facing ptr with crossed-arm hold (as in Fig.B-1). Rock back R and fwd L (ct 3-4). Quick stamp/scuff R without weight near L (ct &). Drop hds to separate. Rhythm is SS,SQQ.

Repeat FIG. C: Jump, Triangles and Twist. Solo: M moves out, W moves into center.

FIG. E: Turn and Loop Right. (E for Ending)

- 1 As in Fig D: Step R to R (ct 1), cross L behind (ct 2), step R in place (ct &), but don't do same to left! Both CCW 2-step full turn towards (next) ptr L, R (ct 3-4). To progress: M move diag. L fwd in LOD to next ptr while W move diag. L fwd in RLOD to next ptr. Rhythm is SQQ,SS.
- 2 Begin a loop right taking R hds low: cha-cha L, R, L (ct 1&2), walk R (ct 3), walk L (ct 4). Rhythm is QQS,SS.
- 3 Continue circling: cha-cha R, L, R, (ct 1&2), then both step L, R, L (ct 3&4): M raising R arm as W spin/tucks CW into Varsouvienne hold. Rhythm is QQS,QQS. End facing LOD ready to repeat dance 2 more times.
