STEFS: All steps are in 6/8 meter: sliding Step (Slip Step)*, Skip change of step*, Fas de kasque*, Set*
Figure of inght ( 8 meas): $W 1$ and W 3 dance between their inactive cpls and loop CW around inactive M, as is 1 and N 3 loop CCW around inactive $W$ ( 4 meas). Then $W 1$ and $W 3$ dance between their inactive cpls and loop iCW around inactive W, while M 1 and M 3 dance CW around inactive $M$ ( 4 meas). the active $W$ always crosses in front of her ptr as she goes between the inactive cpl to begin her loop around, and the l: always crosses behind her.
