Northern Harmony

A 32-bar Jig for 3 couples in a 4-couple set

Bars 1 – 4	$1^{\rm st}$ couple turn with the right hand 1-1/2 times, moving down the set, to finish facing out on opposite sides in second place. $2^{\rm nd}$ couple step up on bars $3-4$.
5 – 12	1 st couple cast off round 3 rd couple, dance up between 3 rd couple, dance out and up round 2 nd couple, and dance down the middle to finish facing first corners (take nearer hands where possible).
13 – 16	1 st couple set to first corners, then to second corners.
17 – 22	1 st couple dance a reel of three with corners, giving right shoulder to second corners to begin.
23 – 24	1 st couple cross to own sides giving right hands to finish in second place.
25 – 32	2 nd , 1 st , and 3 rd couples dance six hands round and back.
	Repeat having passed a couple.

Gregor Trinkaus-Randall started dancing in Boston in 1974. While living in Wisconsin, he and his wife, Vickery, founded the Madison group, which is now an affiliated group of the RSCDS.
