

NEUBAYRISCH  
(Austria)

- Translation: New Bavarian.
- Record: Tanz EP 58102, Side B, Band 2 3/4 meter
- Formation: Couples in a circle, facing LOD, open position,  
inside hands joined.
- Comment: This may be a changing partner dance.

Pattern

Meas

- 1-4 Introduction.
- 1-2 Do two walking waltzes (6 steps) LOD (start with outside feet), swing inside hands fwd (meas 1) and bkwd (meas 2).
- 3 Take single step fwd (M L, W R) ct 1;  
(hold ct 2; ~~M stamp on inside ft and W step on inside ft, ct 3.~~)
- 4 M stamp R; W stamp lightly L, ct 1;  
bring both ft together, ct 2;  
hold, swinging arms slightly bkwd, ct 3.
- 5-8 Repeat action of meas 1-4, but clap instead of stamping.
- 9-12 Moving LOD, W turns 2-1/2 times CW under joined raised hands (M R, W L), M walks fwd (12 steps) alongside ptr.
- 13-20 Repeat meas 1-8.
- 21-36 Waltz in social dance position (6 step Dreher Waltz) moving LOD.

OR

As a Changing Partner Dance

- 35-36 M raises L hand, W turns CW under raised hands and moves forward one position to new partner.
