RUTKALA

from Schoenhengst

Formation: One M between two W on the line of the circle, open hold, inner hands joined.

- 1-4 Beginning L four step-touch diagonally forward in LOD left and right; joined hands swing forward on step and down on touch
- 5-8 the same backward RLD ,hands swing backward and down.
- 1-8 repetition same as 1-8

- 9-10 M hook right arms with R W and turn with running steps, then go to the L W
- 11-12 hook left arms with L W and turn
- 13-16 as 9-12
- 9-16 repetition as 9-16.
